Texas State Society Bylaws - Article VIII

Section 4. Voting Members: The voting members at the State Assembly, or at any special meeting of the State Society, shall be the State Officers, the Honorary State Regents. The National Officers and Honorary National Officers of the National Society whose membership is with the State of Texas, the Chapter Officers, and one additional delegate for every ten (10) members of the State. All voting members must be current with their national and state dues. No voting member or delegate shall be entitled to more than one vote at the State Assembly.

Section 5: Delegates: A list of delegates and alternates to the State Assembly shall be sent by the Chapter Regent to the Chairman of Credentials and to the State Treasurer by the date specified. This list shall be in a format acceptable to the State Society.
